

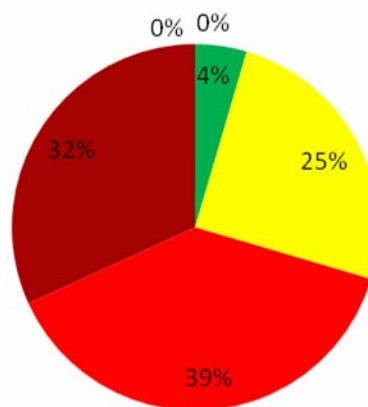

1. How satisfied were you with this thematic meeting overall?

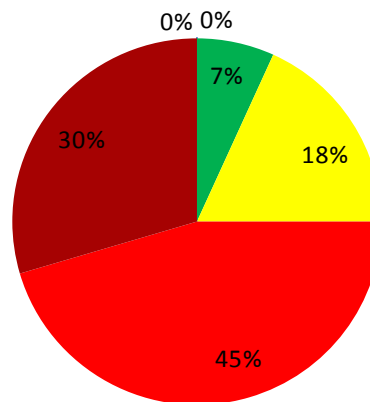

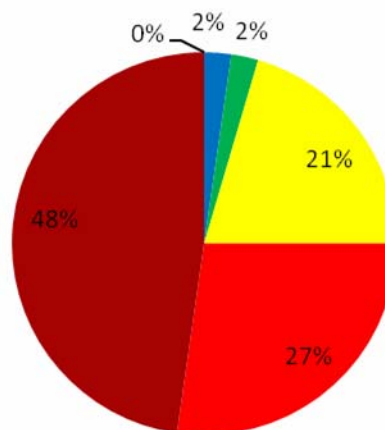
2. How satisfied were you with the quality of the presentations overall?

3. How useful do you consider the meeting to have been for your daily work?

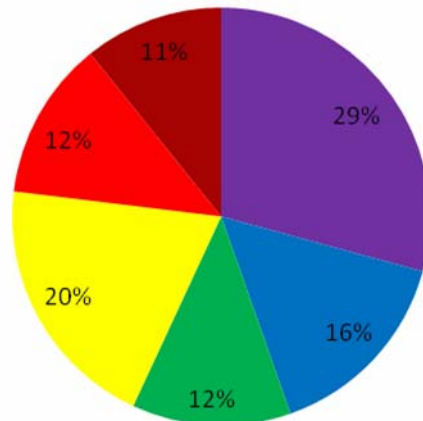

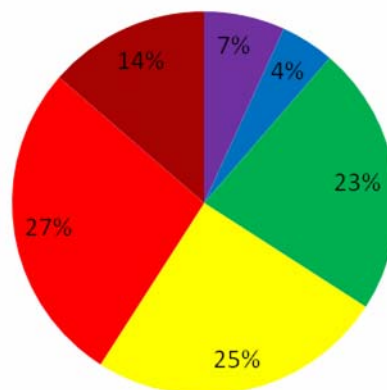
4. Which session did you consider the best one - multiple answers?

5. How satisfied were you with the logistical support provided by the organizers of the meeting?

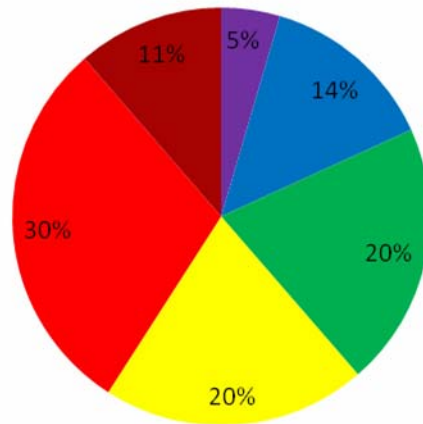

6. How satisfied were you with the facilities for the meeting

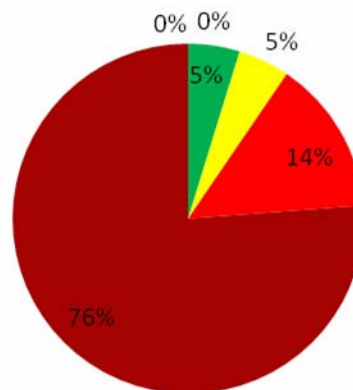

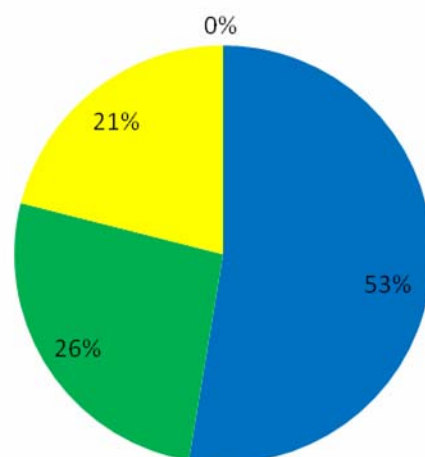
7. Would your Government welcome regular and institutionalized consultative meetings on Migration and Development (Only ECOWAS)
