






Has the creation of a focal point specifically for the GFMD contributed to achieving/launching improved consultations on migration and development within your government?




Are resources (staff, financial or other) available to specifically address links between migration and development as well as coherence with regard to policy planning?




Has the government established, or intend to establish within the next three years, a co-managed migration and development budget line?
