Weather	Average temperatures in Switzerland/Geneva in the month of May range from a low of 14 C° to a high of 21°C.
Electricity	Switzerland uses 220-230 volt current. It is recommended to bring adapters/converters.
Telephone country code	To call Switzerland, you must first dial the country code +41. The local code for Geneva is 022. When placing international calls, dial 00 followed by the country and city codes.
Money	Currency In Switzerland, the official currency is the Swiss Franc (CHF). For updated currency exchange, please check the following site: http://www.xe.com/ucc Indicative exchange rate as of 21 April 2016: 1 CHF = 1.03 USD
	Banks and credit cards ATM machines are abundant; most accept major bank cards and credit cards, and they dispense Swiss francs at the going rate of exchange.
Gratuity	Prices in hotels, restaurants, taxi fares, etc. are calculated to include taxes and service. A tip is not indispensable, but justified for good service. In restaurants, leave 10% of the bill.
